3) Purposes and legal basis for the processing of personal data:

The personal data collected is for strictly professional purposes between two parties acting in the same business sector (B2B). The data collected will be used to send out information on our company in relation to our presence at trade shows, appearance in articles of specialised publications, new products, etc. All such information has a direct connection to surface treatment, i.e. our business activity and that of the recipients.

4) Categories of personal data concerned and recipients:

The data collected may include: Company name, first and surname of contact person, position, address, email address, phone number, and comments on surface treatment.

5) Recipients:

The collected data is for the exclusive use of OMIA as part of sales prospecting in the area of surface treatment.

6) Transfer of personal data to a recipient in a third country or international organisation:

The data collected is strictly confidential and is stored. It is not disclosed to any third company.

7) Storage period for personal data:

Personal data will be stored for 3 years which may be renewed as per the statutory period in force. If the storage period is not renewed, the contact's data will be deleted.

8) Right of access to personal data, right of rectification and erasure of that data, right to restrict or object to the processing of personal data and right to data portability:

A data subject has the right to require that the data controller provide access to their personal data, as well as rectify or erase such data. The data controller may also be required to restrict the processing of data by a data subject. Lastly, a data subject has the right to object to the processing of their data, and the right to data portability.

9) Lodging a complaint with a supervisory authority:
